




What	<p>On June 11, 2026, Adrian Lacour Brooks was arrested without incident in Rapides Parish for one count of Cruelty to Elderly or Persons with Infirmities-First Offense, a violation of La. R.S. 14:93.3.</p> <p>Lacour, a former employee at Westside Habilitation Center's, Adams Group Home, an intermediate care facility for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities, forcefully grabbed an elderly and intellectually disabled resident of the facility, and shoved her, causing her to hit her head on a nearby wall before falling to the ground. This incident occurred on or about September 14, 2025, the resident was later determined to have a spinal injury that rendered her quadriplegic.</p>


Who	Arthur Alexander Bracey

R.S. 14:35.2 A (2).</p> <p>Bracey, a former employee at St. Mary’s Residential Community and Services, a residential facility for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities, was noted on several occasions to have dragged a disabled resident across a laminate floor. In addition, he forcefully slung the client, where his left buttock and hip area slammed into the metal door frame of his room. The incidents occurred on March 28, 2025, and April 6, 2025, and were captured on video surveillance cameras located in the home.</p>

The investigation revealed that Constance Amos Jones, Life Matters Counseling and Therapy owner, altered/falsified training documentation, falsified OIG exclusions search results, and falsified Louisiana state adverse actions search results that are required on all Life Matters Counseling and Therapy staff members. Those falsified documents were submitted to a managed care organization. Life Matters Counseling and Therapy was paid \$44,331.87 by Louisiana Medicaid for services provided by their employees who were not qualified to perform services according to Louisiana Medicaid policy. On June 17, 2026, Jones was arrested for two counts of LA RS 14:133, filing or maintaining false public records. Harris was booked into the Caddo Parish jail with a bond amount set at \$25,000.00.


